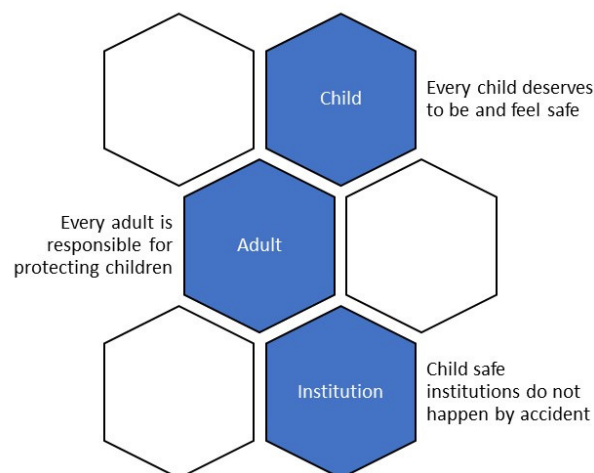


At the end of the session participants will:
